



SUMMARY OF LOCAL CASE DATA WITH COMPARISON TO NATIONAL CONTROLS

71 potential participants accessed the survey, 61 consented, and 57 met eligibility criteria between 6/15 to 6/28.

Face Covering

15.7% of local cases
always/often wore surgical or n95 masks

National Controls (n=3,028)
37% of controls always/often wore surgical or n95 masks



Physical Distancing

35.1% of local cases
always/often avoided crowded places/events

National Controls (n=3,028)
43% of controls always/often avoided crowded places/events

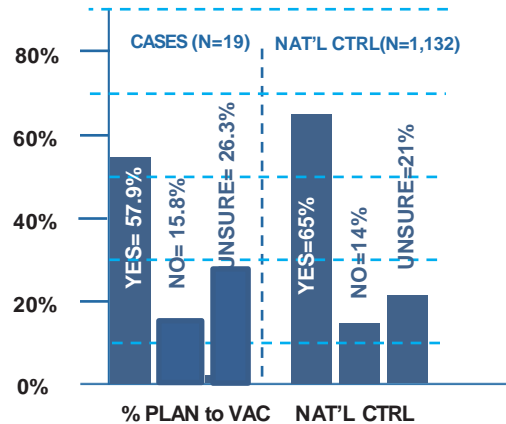

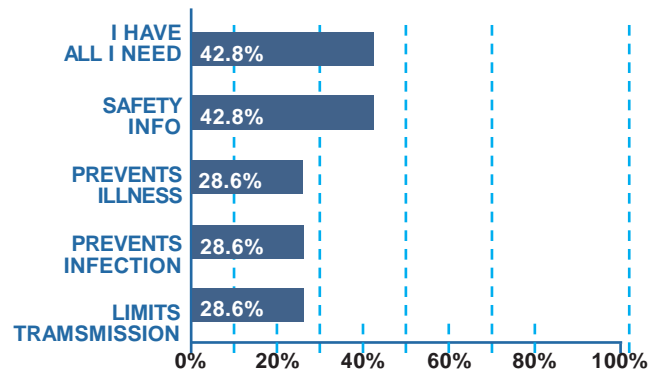

SUMMARY

Most individuals (70.1%) are testing as a result of symptoms. 35% tested as a result of close contact. 21% used PCR and 42.1% rapid testing to confirm positive COVID case, 24.6% used both. 17.5% had tested positive before.
